This project will help support women from refugee, asylum seeker, migrant and racialised communities in Waltham Forest to thrive and access training and employment opportunities."

### Who?


This project is for women and will focus on young women and mothers whose ability to access opportunities that lead to improved stable employment is restricted by their resident status and by their home-life caring/ parenting responsibilities.

### How?

This project will address some of the learning barriers that women from migrant, refugee and racialised communities face when accessing training, qualifications, and better employment.

### Project Outcomes

WISE project will run over a period of 3 years and will work with a minimum of 300 women beneficiaries.

The recruitment target for each year is 100 participants.

#### Education

- 80% of participant will report improvement to conversational language skills
- 70% will gain nationally recognised qualifications

#### **Training & Development**

• 20% will complete occupational training courses to improve their access to employment (childcare + Health and Social care)

#### **Employability**

- 100% will complete an Employability Action Plan
- 25% will secure paid employment
- 25% will secure work placement/work experience
- 80% will report improved opportunities to access better work

#### Wellbeing

- 90% will demonstrate reduced stress and anxiety
- 90% will demonstrate improved mental health and motivation to succeed and gain training/employment
- 85% will report reduced feelings of social isolation and loneliness
- 75% will report significantly increased local community cohesion




